Lon T. Swan was born, 25 Jul 1868, to Enos and Mary (Jones) Swan, b. 1836, Ohio & 1839, Indiana, respectively. Enos died in Portland, OR, 1917. Children of Enos & Mary Swan: Viola (Mrs. Andrew Dahlberg), Portland, OR; Lon; Edward, Butte, MT; Grace (Mrs. Richard Devoe), Emigrant, MT.
